Report by Khan Sophirom: "Cambodia Gets US\$24,768 Million Investment Projects"

Phnom Penh, December 18, 2008 AKP - Foreign investment capital in Cambodia have reached some US\$24,768 million during the past 14 years with China ranked first top ten of foreign investors, Deputy Secretary-General of Cambodia's Investment Committee H.E. Duy Thov said on Dec. 16.

"From 1994 to October 2008, Cambodia has attracted US\$24,768 million investment projects. Of them, 24 per cent are service sector, 22 per cent industry, and 5 per cent agricultural sector. The rest are construction and other sectors," he said.

According to H.E. Duy Thov, China's investment in Cambodia has reached some US\$5,707 million, South Korea US\$2,749 million, Malaysia US\$2,199 million, America US\$1,175 million, EU US\$951 million, Taiwan US\$630 million, Thailand more than US\$500 million, Singapore US\$325 million, Hong Kong US\$273 million, and Vietnam more than US\$200 million.
